Addendum Issue Date: March 8, 2010

Purpose: The purpose of this Addendum is to make changes, additions, deletions, and revisions to the bidding documents dated November 20, 2009 for the above referenced project. Bidders shall review the Addendum work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum may have in their bid price.

Acknowledgement: <u>Bidders must acknowledge receipt of any and all Addenda in the space provided on the</u> <u>Bid Form</u>. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the Bid.

Note: All requirements of the bidding documents remain unchanged except as cited herein.

Part 1 - Amendments to Bid Documents

- Modification to Instructions to Bidders, Section 7.2:
 - Deadline for bidders questions has been changed to Wednesday, March 17, 2010 at 5:00PM.

Part 2 - Questions from Potential Bidders

- Question: Refer to Gates Specification section 26 0533-1.3.B. Specification states "In or Under Slab on Grade: Provide rigid steel conduit, intermediate metal conduit, or PVC schedule 40 conduit." Section 26 0543-3.3.H. states, "Building Entrances: Make a transition from underground duct to rigid steel conduit 5 feet outside the building wall." Since section 26 0533 allows PVC to be used Under Slab on Grade we do not understand the requirement to transition to rigid steel conduit. Please clarify.
- Answer: This would apply where conduit enters building into an area which is below grade. For example, the Electrical Vault North/South Level 01.
- Question: Will you please explain the relationship between Design Pack #4 documents and Design #5 documents. A good deal of confusion has arisen between these two sets of documents because work in one area will be shown differently in design Package #4 than in Design Package #5. Please clarify.

Answer: As of 3/8/10, subcontractors should be bidding Design Package #5, Bulletin #2.

Question: Refer to Gates drawing E0003. On the light fixture schedule, Type F39 is specified to be an illuminated handrail. Which discipline is responsible for installing the illuminated handrail? Answer: This subcontractor is responsible for that scope of work.

Question: Refer to Gates drawing E6005. Detail#7 indicated 2 x 2 steel bracket support assembly for light fixture type F29. Will this bracket be supplied as part of the curtain wall system, or should it be included with the fixture?

Answer: This detail is deleted in Design Package #5, Bulletin #2.
